Prevent Policy

1. Introduction

The International Centre of Excellence (ICE) is dedicated to providing a safe, inclusive, and secure learning environment for its students, staff, and all campus community members. This Prevent Policy is designed to prevent and address issues related to radicalisation, extremism, harassment, and other activities that may disrupt the educational process or pose a threat to individuals or the institution.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all students, faculty, staff, visitors, and anyone associated with ICE. It covers all activities conducted within the premises of the institute and any activities off-campus that are related to or affect the institute's interests.

3. Objectives

The primary objectives of this policy are:

- To identify and prevent activities or behaviours that may lead to radicalisation, extremism, or violence within the educational community.
- To foster an atmosphere of tolerance, diversity, and respect for all members of the institute.
- To comply with relevant laws and regulations while upholding the principles of academic freedom and freedom of expression.

4. Preventative Measures

4.1. Education and Awareness:

International Centre of Excellence provides educational programmes and awareness campaigns to help students and staff recognise the signs of radicalisation, extremism, and other concerning behaviours. These programmes promote understanding, tolerance, and inclusivity.

4.2. Reporting Mechanisms:

The institute establishes confidential reporting mechanisms for students and staff to report any concerns or suspicions related to radicalisation, extremism, harassment, or other disruptive behaviours.

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4.3. Support and Counseling:

ICE also offers support and counselling services to students at risk of radicalisation or with concerns about their peers. Staff and faculty also have access to appropriate support channels.

4.4. Collaboration:
