Dress Code Policy

1. Introduction

ICE is committed to maintaining a respectful and professional learning environment. To promote a sense of modesty and decorum, this Dress Code Policy is established. Violation of the dress code rules may result in penalties as determined by the institution.

2. Dress Code for Male Students

2.1. Desirable And Appropriate Attire

- Slacks/Trousers
- Shirt
- Tie
- Dress shoes with socks
- Shalwar Kameez (clean and properly pressed) with waistcoat (On Fridays only)

2.2. Admissible Attire

- Decent, clean, and pressed jeans with a T-shirt

2.3. Not Allowed/Inadmissible Attire

- Shorts, cut-off jeans, multi-pocketed faded, torn, and skin-fitted jeans/trousers
- T-shirts with inappropriate messages
- Chappals/slippers of any kind
- Long hair or ponytails
- Earrings, chains, wrist straps, bracelets, etc.

3. Dress Code for Female Students

3.1. Desirable and Appropriate Attire

- Traditional Shalwar Kameez and Dupatta
- Chappals and shoes

3.2. Admissible Attire

- Jeans with Kurta/Shirt
- Light jewellery

3.3. Not Allowed/Inadmissible Attire

- T-shirts with fitted jeans
- Sleeveless shirts of any kind
- See-through and skin-tight dresses
- Heavy makeup and jewellery
